

ACTIVITY - A ROUNDABOUT WAY

Why: This activity gives participants the opportunity to practice the road rules around roundabouts and learn how to maneuver them safely.

HOW TO RUN THIS ACTIVITY

Create a series of large roundabout simulations at school (could use chalk, cones, props etc). Make them vary in terms of difficulty – include both simple one-lane roundabouts and more complex multi-lane roundabouts.

Run a lunchtime session giving students the opportunity to practice using these roundabouts in order to familiarise themselves with the rules of driving around roundabouts. If possible, invite a local driving instructor to help run the session

IDEAS OR THINGS TO CONSIDER

- Before running this session, hold an assembly to talk about the activity and introduce how to safely use roundabouts. You could also run a Kahoot quiz to find out what the students already know and to find out where the knowledge gaps are.
- Follow up the activity with another assembly or classroom session to debrief and provide resources for ongoing learning about the rules of roundabouts
