Simple activities

INVITE YOUR LOCAL **POLICE TO AN ACTIVITY**

Steps:

- Plan a SADD activity to run at your school at lunch time. Could be a focus or fail, a road safety themed sports game, soak up some knowledge, or whatever activity you think would work for your school. Make up your own activity, or check out the SADD activities webpage.
- Get in touch with your local police and invite them along. The best way is to get in touch with your Delivery Lead to find out the contact details. Be clear about a date that works for your school and provide a couple of possible dates they can choose from.
- Just get them to come along and attend the event, maybe participate a little, but just to mainly be a presence at the event and be available to chat and engage with students.
- This is a low pressure way to connect with NZP, it doesn't rely on having heaps of time!

RUN KAHOOT NZP

Steps:

- Plan an assembly to run a quiz in
- Invite someone from NZP to come along and help host the quiz with you
- Introduce them
- Run the kahoot
- After the kahoot get the Police Officer to talk briefly about their experiences in the road safety space
- Finish off with a positive message about road safety, that we can all make a difference



Steps:

- Get in touch with your local police
- Invite them to come in and meet with your SADD group.
- This way you can all get to know each other, learn about what they do and they can learn more about SADD and your SADD group
- Then if you want to run an activity with them in the future you have already got that connection
