BRING THE MOBILE ROAD SAFETY BASE IN

Steps

- A lunch time or afternoon event where you invite the Impairment Prevention Team with the Mobile Road Safety Base and create a little event focused on road safety
- Tip: expand the booze bus event into a road safety expo where you invite multiple community partners. Check out this [video](#)
- Each community partner has an area to bring in things and to engage with students, have conversations and run activities

ONGOING VIDEO SERIES

Steps:

- Decide on 4 or 5 different videos you could create and share throughout the year with your local police
- Video ideas: Interview a police officer, conversation about what happens at a crash scene, tour of the Mobile Road Safety Base and tools used for Impairment prevention, and conversation about road safety issues they see
- Make a plan for when you will film and share each video (1 or 2 per term?)
- Share your video series in assembly, form time or social media

A NZP THEMED YEAR

Steps:

- If you have a good relationship with your local police then perhaps you could decide to theme your SADD activities for the year around NZP
- Pick 3 or 4 activities or events to run throughout the year, some of these could be ongoing (such as a video series). Look through the 'simple' and 'medium' activity sheets for ideas.
- Doing a 'NZP Themed' year could build a very strong connection between young people and the police staff and would allow more in-depth conversations and trust to be formed.
